# Win4Icomsuite

Every once in awhile even a blind squirrel finds a nut. Such is the case when I hear about some ham-related software that is something I've wanted but didn't know it even existed. This time, it is Win4IcomSuite. I happened to stumble across it when I had posed a question about HRD and Icom radios on one of the Facebook ham-related groups.

So I looked at it, downloaded and started testing it out and eventually purchased the license. While I am not informed enough about it to write a proper review, I will post some I did find just to introduce you to this software if you've never heard about it (like me!).

Description: Win4IcomSuite is a comprehensive control package for the Icom IC-7100, IC-7300, IC-7610, IC-7600, IC-7700, IC-7850/51, IC-9700 with more radios to follow. It includes support for the built in Spectrum. Scopes of the Icom radios as well as the SDRPlay RSP devices. Win4IcomSuite has 6 virtual radios built in that can interface to any third party software programs including HRDLogbook, DM780, DXLab Suite, N1MM+, Log4OM, N3FJP and many more.

**G8FXC** - I've used several of the leading CAT programs over the years including HRD and DXLabs. They all work reasonably well, but they are all showing their age these days. I tried Win4ICOM on the 30 day eval and liked it, but I had some hardware problems that stopped me using it. I mentioned them in the Groups.IO support group and the author, Tom, came back quickly with some advice that got it working for me, so I bought a license.

*This is a very competently designed and built application which delivers all the functionality of my 7300 through an attractive and, generally, ergonomic screen interface. It loaded and configured easily and I was controlling the rig within minutes. My only criticism of the application is that the screen is not resizable.*

*Having built quite a few Windows applications myself, I can understand why Tom has gone down this path, but I do hope that he will offer a "compact" layout in addition to the current full layout in a future release. The attraction of a computerized shack is the ability to combine a lot of functionality at the same time - log book, DX Cluster, rig control, panadaptor and decoders for various digital modes. This requires a lot of screen real estate and the current Win4ICOM screen takes up a lot of space.*

*Where Win4ICOM really wins is in its ability to integrate a large number of other applications in order to arrive at a serious computerized shack solution. The panadaptor of the 7300 is good for the price, but it is a small screen and can only display the band that the radio is currently tuned to. I've added an SDRPlay RSP1a SDR receiver with the SDRUno software, connected to a RadioAnalog PTRX-7300 in the radio. This links to Win4ICOM so that tuning and mode selection is synchronized. The synchronization can be turned off in which case I get the two receivers that I was used to in my previous radio but are not present in the IC-7300.*

*I also run SwissLog for logging, Bandmaster for a DX Cluster client, FLDigi for the older digi-modes, and WSJT-X for the newer modes. Win4ICOM is able to bind all of these together simultaneously.*

*The combination that I use is not an integrated suite in the way that HRD is, so it is quite a lot more effort to get it all configured so that all the components work together. But on the other hand, I am able to choose the best available solution for each function - the hub functionality of Win4ICOM allows me to mix-and-match to achieve the solution that best meets my needs with the flexibility to swap out individual components if they fall behind.*

**N3HKN** - Works very well. Almost complete control of the 7300, including power on/off. No program crashes and no contamination of Windows10. Updates and support very good. Polite and complete. The MANY features of the 7300 are all laid out on your screen which then

illustrates how extensive the 7300 transceiver process are. It takes awhile to locate some functions but they are there. Add in the DX database, etc.. stuff and it is a top level manager of the most popular transceiver on the market.

The program also manages more than the 7300. Go to the web site for the latest set of supported radios and features.

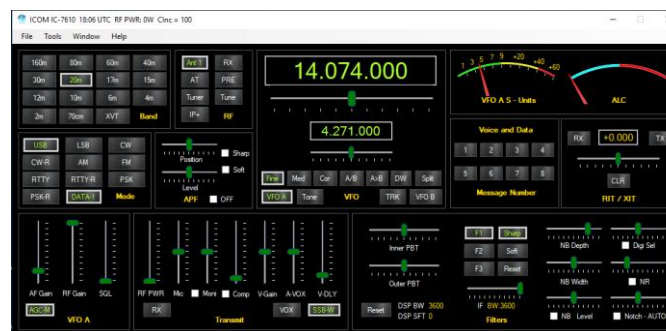
**K8IRB** - It's difficult to say which was more exciting, making my 1st contact back in 1957 or starting up my IC-7300 radio using Win4Icom Suite. Both were thrilling experience.

The software seems flawless and it is loaded with features. I'm using it with my IC-7300, SDR2Pro, WSJT-X, N1MM, MMTTY, GetCW, HRD Logger and DM780. I'm anxious to learn more of the software's features, and to use it in some upcoming contests.

My hats off to Tom and the development group for defining and building this impressive, and stable platform. I think they have established a new standard for others to follow.

We ended up constructing three stations and operated only two at the same time (WFD mode 2-Oscar) using two separate antennas – an Alpha Delta DX-EE parallel dipole and a random-length wire with a 9:1 unun. The club had the shelter reserved for two days as WFD runs from 14:00 local Saturday to 14:00 local Sunday. With the forecast for rain on Sunday we made a decision to operate Saturday only. Our goal was to have fun this weekend and for once do something *in-person* as a club, not win a contest.

By and far, a majority of the stations we made contact with operated 1-Hotel (at home, not
